Headlamp w/ spare batteries

Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, body wipes, biodegradable soap)

Personal Medications / First Aid

Sleeping Bag Liner

Trekking Poles

Gaiters (just below the knee, heavy material that will not rip if caught on your crampon)

Hiking Socks (light and heavyweight)

Fleece Pullover or Hoodie

Fleece Pants

Waterproof Jacket

Waterproof Pants

Warm Waterproof Gloves / Mittens

Thin Gloves

Ski Goggles

Camp Towel

Sun Hat / Baseball Cap

Reusable 1L Water Bottle

Glacier Sunglasses (w/ UV protection and side guards)

Snacks (small, carb based, easy to eat, jerky, dried fruit, candy, bars)
